Mrs. Sarah Cortez, Founder and President of Catholic Literary Arts, provided an update on the next Fearless Catholic Writing Camp on June 10 - 14 at The University of St. Thomas. The Writing Camp started six (6) years ago as a non-profit with 50 students attending and has averaged 50% growth rate each year. This year we expect two Hundred (200) children to attend the weeklong camp. She made an appeal for scholarships and personal donations to support students who want to attend but family finances will not allow them to attend. Ms. Cortez presented testimonies from families that have asked for scholarships to assist their child in attending. The cost for one student attending the camp is \$275.00. Secretary's Report: Chapter Secretary - Vincent Stasio

Recognizing Fr. Paul, Worthy State Dignitaries, State Visitors and Brother Knights.

- A brief report tonight on attendance: eleven (11) State, Archdiocesan and Chapter Dignitaries, seventeen (17) District Deputies, forty (40) Council Delegates and two (2) visitors, did sign in, one being Mrs. Cortez. That is all I have to report. I now turn the meeting back to our worthy Chapter President, JD.
- Chapter President JD noted the meeting minutes for March were distributed via e-mail and also posted on the Chapter website. Do we have any corrections to the meeting minutes as posted? Any corrections, any corrections? Hearing none, called for a motion to accept the meeting minutes. Motion was made to accept the meeting minutes as posted, seconded and minutes are approved.
- Communications: The Chapter received three such communications:
 - **First:** communications for the "COOL" group, a lengthy letter, essentially containing their "State of the Union" message on what is to come next year and asking for financial support on their efforts with "pro-life." If you want to read this letter, I have it with me and you can read it after tonight's meeting. The Chapter does provide a monitory donation. **Second:** We did receive a check (money back) from the Stafford Center, but don't know exactly why, but will explore it. I have asked our Chapter Treasure, Brother Cantrell, to look into it and report back to the membership.

Third: We received vintage photographs of the Texas Knights of Columbus from the 1920's, and it is posted on this board to my left, received from a women, Shella Boshare(?) from Fargo, North Dakota. Her great uncle Ed Weinberg was a Knight of Columbus and band member in Houston. These photos show and is titled, "the Knights of Columbus band in San Antonio and Houston and Knights from Houston and noted she did not want them to be lost, so sent them to us here in Houston. We believe they have some historical and archival value, So now, what are we to do with them. We don't know of a "KC Museum" here in Texas,

State Deputy Terry Fugue noted that we do have a State of Texas Archives for the "good stuff" and that is probably where this will go. He noted that Past Texas State Deputy, Doug E. Oldmixon is the Historian for the State in Austin, and he will know what to do with it. We, the Texas State Knight help fund the Catholic Archives. Terry will deliver these photos to PSD Doug Oldmixon. That is all I have on Communications.

<u>George Brooks – Culture of Life</u> (the complete transcript as published by Dr. Brooks follows below) Recognize: Fr. Paul, Worthy State Officers, Diocesan Deputy, Chapter Officers, and Brothers All.

I sent out in separate emails and information sheet on how to conduct a "Baby Bottle Boomerang" as a fundraiser and I also sent an information sheet on how to fill a bus to Austin for the Texas Rally for Life next January..

If you have any questions, ask your District Deputy or pick up my card/contact information and sent me an e-mail so I can help. Coog's For Life: They did a couple of demonstrations concerning the "so-called" Satanic Golden Medusa, I placed photos on the back table, If you care to make a donation to support them, UofH charges a \$750 fee and they are strapped for money. If you can contribute to the efforts, please send me an e-mail and I will provide information on how to send that in. It is important that we create a body of "pro-life" leaders for tomorrow.

Margaret Hotze: I put some information on the table, as she passed away on March 27. After the Supreme court ruled in Roe vs. Wade in January 1973, she co-founded the Texas Right to Life. Later that year she helped open the first crisis pregnancy center and founded *The Life Advocate*, the only Life newspaper in Texas and served as editor. Go on-line and look up her obituary, she was a stanch support of Right to Life. After reading her obituary it will make you think that you have not done much

Gabriel Projects: Also remind councils to consider making (and budgeting) a donation to their parish Gabriel Project and to those parishes where Gabriel Projects are under pressure from women with significant needs. I have not attached information in order not to clutter this newsletter.

Remind the councils to send me the Donation Receipt Letter and the parish W-9 form so I can apply to Supreme and Chapter for additional grant money to these Gabriel Projects recipients. Have them contact me if they do not know how this works and you are unable to explain it.

ACE Wings: Encourage councils that do not have a program to start an ACE Wings program. Have them contact me for information, and I will be happy to visit and help them get started.

For those who have an ACE Wings program, I am likewise eager to help any way I can, for example help with motivating men to participate. At the same time, I have had much success enrolling new members to the council in the ACE Wings program. I meet them at the CUF and sign them up. Becoming qualified to wear the ACE Wings is part of their formation as a new Knight. I will contact them to participate in qualifying Pro-Life events and keep track of the events they have completed.

I have not attached more information on those events that are qualified for the ACE Wings program, but I have an explanatory document for those men that I am eager to share.

Pregnancy Centers: Don't forget about the pregnancy centers the need help or Ultrasound machines. Please e-mail me and I will help wherever and whenever.

- 1. Everyone grab a pen and write this date down; April 18 at 7:00pm CST. There is a webinar titled, "Practical tips for a strong finish." I need you to get this out to all of the Grand Knights. District Deputies need to go on-line right now and register for this presentation. DDs were sent a registration site, and you need to view this webinar, Galveston-Houston needs a strong finish. We are on track to do better than last year, but that doesn't mean we will actually do better. We need Star Council. Getting Star means you are supporting your Pastors and Parishes. Pastor's tell me they need help!!
- 2. SP-7: DDs I need you to fill out a SP-7 for each of your councils. You know your councils and you go to all their events. and you know what they do. So, fill out an SP-7 and then meet with the Grand Knight and review it with him. We have GK's that do not realize all the councils has done already. Some of the Grand Knights have turned theirs in, but many have not. We need to get this done now, don't wait for June, do it now,
- 3 Star Districts: three District Deputies in the State already have made Star District, one in Dallas and two are in Galveston Houston, that's Rick Johnson and Bob Schmidth. Thank you guys (applause by all). That means they have Star Councils. We have five DD's in the top 25 in Texas and hopefully all five will make Star District. If your council has completed the four Programs and achieved sixteen credits, get them turned in. Many of the Councils are good at turning in the Form 10784. If you council is not so good at it, I ask the GK's and FS's to make sure you turn in a completed Form 10784 for each program. I do not want to see the SP-7 turned back due to lack of information. All the Program information is to be listed the 10784 as there is no room to expound on the SP -7
- 4 Membership: we are doing pretty good this month, as we are at 36.11% of our membership goal for April. We have a "boat load" of exemplifications coming up this month. I encourage you to get your e-membership roles down by getting the e-members to an exemplification. The on-line exemplifications are working really well, There are a number of Councils doing these with much success. Use the on-line exemplifications if this is what it takes to get them in.

- 5 Star Tracker: please check your Star Tracker, which tracks all the programs needed for Star. We are falling behind on Safe Environment and Fraternal Benefits. Safe Environment, if we are out supporting our kids and families, I don't understand why we are not getting Directors and Grand Knights into the training. It is almost too late, as the deadline is May 1st. If you do not have your members certified before the end of this month you cannot make Star Council no matter how well you do with membership or programs.
- Fraternal Benefits: We had a bunch of members attend the Fraternal Benefits webinar on April 2nd.Grand Knights make sure you get the names turned in. No other webinars are scheduled right now, so you may have to do in-person events.
- 7 Affiliate Membership Initiative: AMI's are due in May. You need to get those members names to the District Deputies.
- 8 Supreme Per-Capita. There are some councils that have not paid yet. I sent that information out to the District Deputies. Pre-Capita is due tomorrow, so you need to go on-line and pay by credit card or you will be suspended. If you council is suspended you cannot vote for the Chapter Officers or send delegates to the State Convention.
- 9 Texas State Convention: we still need volunteers and helpers. The Friday night event is in need of people to help. We need people to sign up for Country Store to sell convention products and items. We have good leaders but they need helpers to man the sales tables. There are a bunch of other tasks that need helpers, Don Quintero will need helpers in setting up the Altar and Sacred item for both Saturday and Sunday Mass and moving the Altar off the stage after mass. We need volunteers to haul these items from the Dominican Center to the Hotel and then back on Sunday/Monday.
- 10 Coog's for Life: I do want to ask for monetary support/donations for the Googs for Life. They ran the protest march against the Golden Medusa, that Dr. George talked about, and had to pay the University a fee for security and cleanup. We need to help them out, as it is about \$700 for each event. If you can donate please send checks to the Chapter, and in the memo line note "dedicated funds Goog's for Life." David Bartlett is the president of the Goog's for Life and joined the Knights at the exemplification last month, which brought in four new members He is a strong individual. The Finish Line is sent to all, At the beginning, it has a 30-60-90-day outlook of everything that is going on it the State. Articles from me and other State Directors with a lot of good information. The key items this time cover the State Convention. Some high-lights, your *Council must have State Per-capita paid* or Delegates will not be seated, You need to show a current and valid 3rd Degree membership card or an Honorary Life Membership Card. Please ask your Delegates to be on time for all the events and meetings. There is a lot going on and we crammed a lot of information into each session. This is a good chance to attend and learn from the Education Sessions, two on Friday afternoon and two on Saturday, You will have a list of these sessions prior to coming. Please have you guys be there on time
- 2. Hotel registration deadline is this Thursday, April 11, Registrations are to come through the State Office. There you will also register for the events and pay for your rooms and events. I want to give a "Big" thanks to the Galveston-Houston Convention Committee, You all did a fantastic job putting this together. Thank You...
- **3.** I want to Congratulate the Councils that won the "Banners" from the Supreme contest that brought in 6 new members in the three-month period. There were 90 winners across the state. Galveston Houston had 24.
- **4.** Wheelchairs: We heard tonight that Galveston-Houston currently raised \$74,000.00. Statewide we brought in over \$800,000.00 by the end of March. There was a council in Dallas the raised \$30,000.00 this past weekend, The wheelchair guys dis some a heck of a job and are shooting for One Million Dollars by end of the Fraternal year.
- 5. SP-7: I get copies of them, and it is amazing the forms that come in with errors and omissions. Some show a Council that meets a minimum of twelve (12) times a year and lists no money being dispersed and/or no hours listed for charitable activities. This cannot be correct. In some cases they may not understand the form. I will have an updated list and distribute it to all the Diocesan Deputies to follow up with DDs and the Councils. DDs normally do not get copies of the reports, but I want you to know what is being turned in, work to educate the process.
- **6.** State Charities: you guys are doing a great job in donating to State Charities. The state is just shout of 96% of our Charity Goal, about \$29,000.00 short of our State Charity goal. Galveston-Houston has already surpassed 100% of their Charity goal.
- 7. Clergy and Seminarian Luncheon, also has a cut-off date of April 2nd. As of end of the month we may have as many as 6 or 7 Bishops attending. We know that Cardinal DiNardo will be attending and doing one of the Masses, Also Bishop Sis our State Chaplain will do the Memorial Mass on Sunday morning. I know we will have a 4th Degree turn-out at the Masses.
